

## **Simons Postdoctoral Position in Theoretical Cosmology**

The Center for Theoretical Physics at Columbia University expects to have a postdoctoral position available in theoretical cosmology, nominally starting September 1, 2018. The initial appointment will be for one year, renewable up to three years contingent on continued funding and satisfactory performance. A PhD in Physics, Astrophysics, or a related area is required.

The postdoctoral fellow will be supported by funds provided by the Simons Foundation under the program entitled Cosmological Bounces & Bouncing Cosmologies (<http://bouncingcosmology.com>) as part of the Origins of the Universe Initiative. The fellow will be invited to participate in all program activities. Interested candidates with a wide range of backgrounds, which might include cosmology, general relativity or high energy physics, will be considered.

Candidates should submit with their application a cover letter, curriculum vitae (including publication list), and a brief statement of their research plans through [AcademicJobsOnline](#). Three letters of recommendation are required and should be submitted directly through the AJO website.

Applications will begin to be reviewed on December 1, 2017 and will continue until the position is filled.
